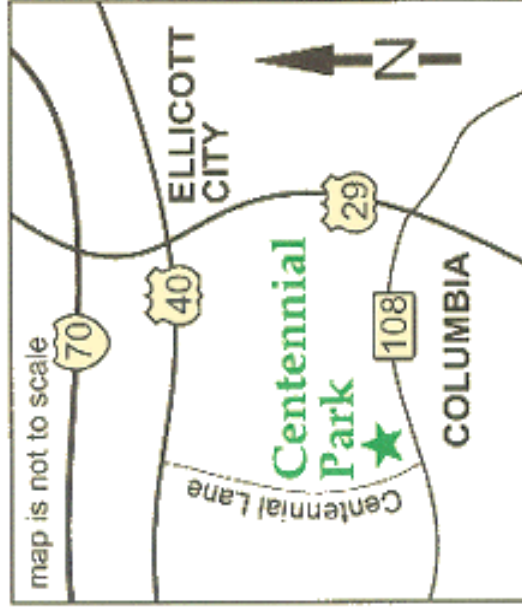


**DIRECTIONS: to Centennial Park - Shelter O**



From Interstate 70:

Take Route 29 South toward Columbia. Proceed with directions from Route 29 below.

From Interstate 95:

Take Route 100 West via Exit 43 toward Elliptic City. At the end of Route 100, bear left onto US Route 29 South toward Washington. Immediately get into the right lane.

From Route 29:

Take Exit 21, Route 108 West toward Clarksville. Proceed through two traffic lights (passing the main entrance to Centennial Park) approximately 1.7 miles to third light at Centennial Lane. Turn **RIGHT** onto Centennial Lane. Pass Centennial Lake on right. Turn right into park.

Pavilion O is at the end of the parking lot past soccer fields, tennis courts and softball fields.

**SANCTIONED BY:** The American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV), promoting leisure sports in the interest of family health, recreation, fun and companionship.

- REGISTRATION:** There is no pre-registration for these events.
- The participation fee for IVV Credit only is \$3. (maximum \$10 for families with minor children living together)
  - *There is no fee to walk the trail without receiving the IVV credit or award.*
  - There is a \$4.50 fee to enter the petting farm and visit the animals.

**COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:** There are two events, Each with a 10 km trail. There will be a shorter 5-km option. All are rated 2. The Farm Trail will feature Clark's Elioak, a 540-acre working farm with a part which includes a petting area, playground, evergreen tree maze and displays from the original Maryland theme park, Enchanted Forest. There is a fee of \$4.50 to enter the area. The walk goes past but not into this area. The trail is mostly on farm truck roads. The Lake Trail will feature Centennial Lake and adjoining neighborhoods.

Trail ratings are on a scale of 1 (easiest) to 5 (hardest).

**PROCEDURE:** Each participant will be issued a start card. It must be carried on the walk and presented for validation at each checkpoint. Only one start card will be validated per participant. Start cards must be turned in at the Finish Table after completing the event. Only those participants with a properly validated start card will be eligible for the Event Award and/or IVV credit. The trail may be walked two times per start card on the same day at no additional cost.

## START/FINISH:

The walk will start at Centennial Park West, Pavilion O, 4651 Centennial Lane, Ellicott City, Maryland 21042. (See directions on back cover.)

## STARTING TIMES:

8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Must be finished by 3:00 pm.

**AWARD:** There are no awards for these walks. Some B Awards for previous events will be available for purchase.

**REFRESHMENTS:** Water and restrooms will be located at the start and finish point. A checkpoint on the trail will have water and port-a-pots. **Bob Schmick will be manning the grill bringing his infamous Bob's Brats to this event.**

**CONDITIONS:** The events will be held during all reasonable weather conditions, including rain. Littering along the trails is prohibited. County laws require that all pets be leashed.
