Faiz-e-Aam Muslim Inter College An Institution of Modern & religious Learning

Faiz-e-Aam Muslim Educational Society established Faiz-e-Aam Muslim School in 1998 for promoting education among backward communities particularly Muslims in a backward area. This is a progressing institution in a rural area with a clear vision to build up a bright future. The college emphasises on promoting good education with a new outlook towards success. During 8 years with the support of guardians and well wishers it developed into an intermediate college. Outstanding achievement was to establish 23 primary schools in remote villages with well defined vision and mission for basic education. It made substantial progress in every field, notably academic, religious and social activities. It's academic achievement can be gauged from the excellent result. On social front it worked for poverty alleviation on small scale with meager fund.

Unlike commercial private schools, our tuition fee is nominal and donation is the only source for developing basic infrastructure. During the year, the construction of 2 classrooms had been possible with the donation of parents and well wishers. With addition of classrooms classes held in open was discontinued which was great relief to students.

Bombay born philanthropist Dr. Ebrahim Kazim desired to establish a girls school in memory of his mother. A 3 storey block consisting of 14 classrooms was suggested to him. Later on the construction work was taken up enabling the management to separate girls classes. From the next session Amina Abedin Memorial Girls Hr. Sec. will run in new block. The existing North Block has been attached to this school.

In XIIth class 22 girls student took admission in other college, as transport charges was felt as burden. So only 18 girl students appeared in U.P. Board Exam. It appears unavoidable to introduce co-education in intermediate classes. In the next session Maths will also be introduced beside Art subjects. Low salary to teachers due financial stringency, the management faces shortage of teachers. However the quality education is not compromised.

Social Front

Faiz-e-Aam Muslim Educational Society is not working only for educational upliftment of the community. It cares for health and happiness of the people. Some of the activities are reported below.

- As in last years, a Free Medical Camp was organized in Faiz-e-Aam on 28.1.07. A team of reputed doctors of the city Dr. Abdus Salam (Orthopedic Surgeon), Dr. Javed Akhtar (Physician), Dr. Iqbal (Physician), Dr. Saliha Iqbal (Gynaecologist), Dr. Kaif Rizvi (Dentist), Dr. Vipin Kumar (General Surgeon), Dr. R.K. Shukla (Child Specialist) and Doctors of Ayodhya Eye Hospital examined 1035 patients of 55 villages and gave free medicines. There were maximum patients of general and eye diseases.
- 2. Another free Medical Camp was organized in Dr. M.Z. Khan Girls H. Sec. School, Patranga on 19.11.06. Dr. Abdus Salam (Orthopedic Surgeon), Dr. Javed Akhtar (Physician), Dr. Afroz Khan (Physician), Dr. Iqbal (Physician), Dr. Saliha Iqbal (Gynaecologist), Dr. Kaif Rizvi (Dentist) and a team of Ayodhya eye Hospital participated in the camp. They examined, advised and gave free medicines to 950 patients of 35 villages.
- **3.** Copies Qur'an Kareem was distributed to Guardian and students.
- 4. The Society managed Qurbani and distribution of meat on behalf of persons who could not make arrangement to fulfill their religious obligation Qurbani of 38 buffaloes, 4 goats was performed and meat was distributed to 1485 poor families of 32 villages. Hide was given to Madarsas where orphans and poor seek religious knowledge.
- **5.** (a) During Ramzan 136 packets containing eight articles for sehr & Aftar were distributed to poor Rozedars with the contribution of well wishers of Muslim Ummah.

(b) In Makkhu Khan Purwa Branch of our school 70 student observing fast were offered Aftar in the mosque.

- **6.** With the generous contribution 'Aftar' was also organized in mosques of Makkhu Ka Purwa, Sukhipur and Kopepur village. These are poverty ridden villages with Muslim majority.
- **7.** (a) On the occasion of Eid-Azha 140 poor guardians of Noorul Islam J.H. School part of Faizabad Literacy Project received Sewai, sugar and milk.

(b) On eve of Eid 130 Yatim girls and boys of Noorul Islam J.H.School, Faiz-e-Aam and affiliated schools received clothes.

(c) 49 very poor Muslims of villages received clothes on the occasion of Eid.

(d) In winter 20 blankets & 7 quilts distributed to poor Muslims.

On our request Br. Junaid Khan (Alig) and Br. Khursheed Ali Khan (Alig) extended study loan to 4 students for higher studies.

- **3.** Purchasing land for Faiz-e-Aam College play ground 12,000 sq.ft. estimated cost Rs. 12.0 lac.
- Construction of Biology lab for Intermediate classes estimated cost Rs. 3.5 lac.

Affiliated institutions for grassroot level learning and educational awakening in rural areas

A study sponsored by the Centre revealed that attendance of Muslim children in UP's primary and upper primary classes were 56.11% 65.9% respectively. Due to ignorance and poverty large number of children don't go to school. For mass awakening for learning and to provide value based education at grassroot level Afmi Primary Schools have been established in villages with dominant Muslim population. The goal is 100% literacy by mass movement for spread of The majority consists of poor and deprived persons, so their education. children are given all support for learning. Every year the growth of student strength is definitely good sign of awakening and popularity of Afmi Primary Schools.

Development of Basic Infrastructure

Due to shortage of classroom in Babhangawan, Mangalsi, Ahrauli, Kopepur 150 children are still sitting on ground under open sky. In some schools two classes are held in one classroom. This is happening due unavoidable circumstances. Paucity of fund has created this situation. This year there has been no appreciable progress in development.

Talent Search

There is good talent in rural area. The children need attention of parents. Our effort has been to search such students and ensure that they continue the studies.1201 talented poor student have been adopted under talent search scheme.

High Lights

In academic session 2006-07 the strength of student rose to 2875 with some set backs.

- New branches in village Barahwan and Sewan were established. But Sewan Branch was high jacked by the person who was instrumental in establishment.
- Afmi Primary School at Bhagwabheet and Wazeerganj were upgraded by one class. Now 14 branches are fulfledged primary schools.
- 50 Students passed out from different branches competed in admission test in A.I.T college and Faiz-e-Aam and got admission in VIth standard.
- In Dr. M.Z. Khan Girl H.S. School the incharge and some teachers left the school when their involvement was found in activities detrimental to the institution.
- Babhangawa branch was upgraded to class VIth. Construction of one classroom each from M.P and M.L.A fund was taken up.
- With the donations, 70 Table cum Seats for 350 students were provided in different branches.
- Poor student in 4 branches were provided school dress.
- MU Alumni, Australia sponsored 100 poor students.
- One computer was added in Dr. Ebrahim Kazim Computer Centre with the donation of AMU Alumni Australia.
- AMU Alumni Australia funded construction of 8 toilets in 4 schools. 9 Hand Pumps installed in 9 schools with their contribution.
- Human Concern International, Canada sponsored 42 poor students and received contribution to start construction of a classroom in Faiz-e-Aam.
- 162 Student completed Qur'an Nazira
- AMU Alumni, Lucknow sponsored 22 poor student in Radiance Islamic Nursery School under Faizabad Literacy Project.
- Charity Alliance New Delhi sponsored 11 poor girl students of Maktab Islamia Girls College Unchegaon Faizabad under Faizabad Literacy Project.

Sponsorship

In community where 94.9% live below poverty line the education is luxury. Higher education is dream due to very high expenses. So poverty and education are interrelated. In our schools we provide ample opportunity to poor for learning with the support of generous persons. Beside exemption of fees, books, exercise books, dress etc are provided. During winter sweater/scarf are given to sponsored students. In year 2006-07, 230 sweater, scarf were given in school under Faizabad Literacy Project.

If opportunity of learning had not been provided to poor student, they would have been engaged by parent in petty works for meager income. At present poverty is the main reason for not sending children to school by poor parent. In each school demand is for free education which is not possible due to teacher's salary.
