Covering letter

My hobby has been for a long time now has been building and programming computers. When I decided to further my education IT seemed a natural choice. The major of my degree focused on the

more technical aspects of IT i.e. programming, database management systems, networking graphics, the minor was the uses of IT to educate and train.

After graduating I worked in the IT department of Chester and Halton community NHS trust. I learnt a lot there about the practical uses of IT.

I did achieve the setting up of an Intranet with searchable databases; these included a telephone database and a nation wide General Practitioner locator. My duties there also included NT administration ,Exchange, NHS NET ,ISDN, Hardware Maintenance and front line support.

Since leaving the NHS I have worked for Wirral Borough Council.

I am employed here as a technical author to help implement a European bid. The bid was to equip all Wirral schools with networks and connect them to the Internet via isdn ,and to create a Wirral Internet site that was rich in educational resources.

My first task was then to make sure the people who were contracted to install the isdn infrastructure fulfilled their contracts. My second task was to take ownership of a co located server in London and administer it remotely from Wirral.

The server runs NT and IIS4, transaction server SMTP server. We have designed the site from scratch and liased with teachers and general inspectors to either create content or have it converted to pdf or html. The team I work with consists of a project manager, another technical author , myself and a technician who concentrates on office administration video and music.

My role within this team is best described as programmer and IIS administrator. The project has been a great success and is almost guaranteed to fund for many years by Wirral Borough council. All programming is done in either ASP Visual Basic or Open Script.
