4. SIGNAL	0950 Attention signal (repeated horn blast) 0955 warning signal (Hisf flag up, 1 horn blast) 1000 start (Hisf flag down, 1 horn blast)
5. COURSE	R N "2" N. of Herring I. Shoal - (C) - leave to port R N"6" NE of Tilghman Point - (Q) - leave to port R "2A" FI R 4s Bell - (F) - North of Wades Point - leave to starboard G "1" FI G 4s Bell South of Kent Point (L) - leave to starboard G "1" FI G 4s (Z) - NE of Curtis Point - leave to port
6. TIME LIMIT	1600 HOURS
