KELLEY RISTAU RECEIVES INTERNATIONAL APPOINTMENT!

Kelley Ristau, long-time CCFSC member and USFS Technical Specialist for Synchronized Skating, recently had the privilege of being one of five United States officials nominated by USFS to attend this year's International Skating Union Global Seminar in Frankfurt, Germany. The intensive week-long school was attended by 168 other Judges, Referees, Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists from Singles, Pairs, Dance and Synchronized Skating.



At the end of the week, participants were required to pass comprehensive exams in their areas of expertise. As a result of successfully passing these examinations, Kelley received an appointment as an International Technical Specialist for Synchronized Team Skating and is now eligible to serve as an official for international synchronized skating events. Currently, Kelley is one of only two synchronized skating Technical Specialists from the United States qualified to participate in international competitions. The other is Kelley's coach from Team del Sol, Karen Wiesmeier.

Although at least 12 hours of each day during the seminar were devoted to lectures and practice sessions, Kelley was able to spend a day prior to the start of the seminar visiting some of the historic sections of Frankfurt. In addition, she enjoyed the opportunity to escape the conference center during meal times to try local restaurants in the vicinity of the hotel. She explored other parts of the city and the surrounding forests on daily runs—in part to counteract eating all that delicious German bread. Kelley said she would like to go back some day to explore more of the country via Radwegs—a network of bike trails that cross the country.

Kelley will be in Roseville in October to work with the Sierra Storm and Capital Ice synchro teams.
