- q Each scene must have a small description of what is happening
- q Each scene must include the chapter and page number

- q Explain what literary devices (theme, setting, imagery, etc.) the author uses in the scene
- q Each paragraph should be at least 7 sentences
- q Paragraphs should be typed (12 point font, double spaced) or written neatly (skipped lines, black or blue pen)
