

Backpacking Equipment Check List – Weekend Trip

Troop will provide tents, cook stoves and cooking gear

Do not allow pack + gear to exceed 25% of scout's weight.

Scout Handbook (in ziplock with pad & pen/pencil)
Backpack (external frame)
Daypack
Sleeping Bag (w/liner if temps will be under freezing)
Ground Pad (closed cell foam or thermarest)
Small Pillow
Flashlight w/extra batteries
Whistle
Compass
Pocket Knife (if earned Tot N Chip)
10 – 15 feet of Nylon Rope
Large Trash Bags to use for pack cover if rain
Camp stool (optional)

Water Bottle (plastic - no metal canteens)
Bowl, Plate, Cup
Knife, Fork, Spoon

Small First Aid Kit
Toothbrush & Toothpaste (look for travel sizes)
Soap & Washcloth
Deodorant
Small Roll of Toilet Paper
Sunscreen
Bug Spray (non-aerosol only)

Class A Uniform (worn when traveling)
Scout hat
Rain Gear (poncho or 2 piece suit)
2 Scout T-Shirts (or plain gray if scout t-shirt unavailable)
1 Pair Pants (no nylon)
2 pair Socks
2 pair underwear
Long Underwear (polyester only – no cotton) and knit cap for cold nights
Hiking Boots (already broken in)
Extra pair of shoes
Cold weather clothes: coat, knit cap, gloves
