

## More on the <IMG> tag...

SRC="URL" (required)

URL is the location of the image file

HEIGHT="XX"

Height in pixels of the image file

WIDTH="YY"

Width in pixels of the image file

BORDER="ZZ"

Size of the border, in pixels (select 0 if you don't want a border)

ALIGN="LEFT/RIGHT/TOP/MIDDLE/BOTTOM"

Alignment of the image in relationship to the surrounding text

ALT="text"

Alternative text which is displayed if the browser cannot process the image

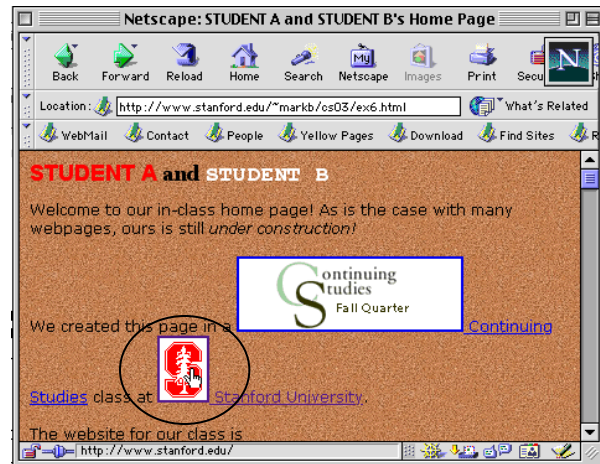
So, a complete <IMG> tag might look like:

<IMG SRC="http://www.stanford.edu/~markb/cs21/su.gif" WIDTH="38" HEIGHT="50"  
BORDER="0" ALT="Stanford Logo">
```

## To find the width & height of an image:

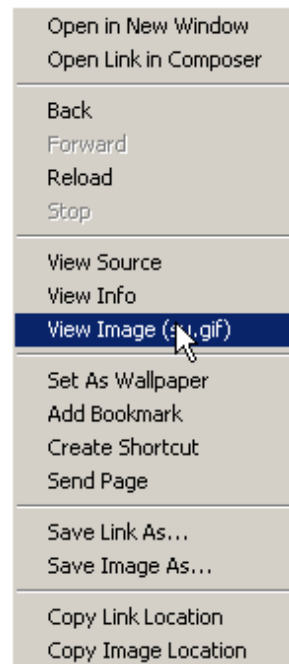
1. Launch Netscape and locate the website that has the image

2. Place the mouse over the image



3. On a PC, press the right-click button. On a Macintosh, press and hold the mouse button.

4. A dialog box will appear. Select "Open this Image" (Macintosh) or "View Image" (PC).



5. Look in the title bar. The image size should be displayed in pixels: Width x Height
