#### SRC="URL" (required) URL is the location of the image file

### HEIGHT="XX"

Height in pixels of the image file

## WIDTH="YY"

Width in pixels of the image file

# BORDER="ZZ"

Size of the border, in pixels (select 0 if you don't want a border)

### ALIGN="LEFT/RIGHT/TOP/MIDDLE/BOTTOM"

Alignment of the image in relationship to the surrounding text

#### ALT="text"

Alternative text which is displayed if the browser cannot process the image

So, a complete <IMG> tag might look like:

# To find the width & height of an image:

- 1. Launch Netscape and locate the website that has the image
- 2. Place the mouse over the image
- 3. On a PC, press the right-click button. On a Macintosh, press and hold the mouse button.
- A dialog box will appear. Select "Open this Image" (Macintosh) or "View Image" (PC).
