4. Sunday, May 8 - pm - complete tear down.

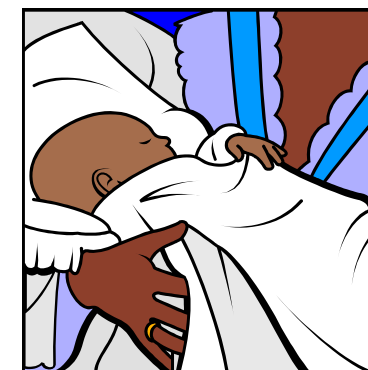
