## Directions to DeCordova Museum and Sculpture Park, Lincoln

## **Directions from Route 128/I-95 (north of Route 2)**

Heading south, follow the DeCordova signs to exit 28A-B, Trapelo Road. Take a right on Trapelo Road. You will drive approximately 3 miles to Lincoln center, a five road intersection. Sandy Pond Road is directly ahead. The DeCordova Museum is approximately 1/2 of a mile on your right.

## **Directions from Route 128/I-95 (south of Route 2)**

Heading north, follow the DeCordova signs to exit 28B, Trapelo Road/Lincoln. You will drive approximately 3 miles to Lincoln center, a five road intersection. Sandy Pond Road is directly ahead. The DeCordova Museum is approximately 1/2 of a mile on your right.

#### Directions from Route 3 or 93 (north of the Mass Pike)

Travel southbound to Route 128 South. Follow the DeCordova signs to exit 28A-B, Trapelo Road. Take a right on Trapelo Road. You will drive approximately 3 miles to Lincoln center, a five road intersection. Sandy Pond Road is directly ahead. The DeCordova Museum is approximately 1/2 of a mile on your right.

#### Directions from Route 93 North (south of the Mass Pike)

Take 93 northbound to the Mass Pike. Take the Mass Pike to Route 128/I-95. Head north to exit 28B, Trapelo Road/Lincoln. You will drive approximately 3 miles to Lincoln center, a five road intersection. Sandy Pond Road is directly ahead. The DeCordova Museum is approximately 1/2 of a mile on your right.

#### **Directions from Route 2 (east of Route 128)**

If you are travelling on Route 2 westbound, take Route 128 south. Your next exit is Trapelo Road/Lincoln. Take a right on Trapelo Road. You will drive approximately 3 miles to Lincoln center, a five road intersection. Sandy Pond Road is directly ahead. The DeCordova Museum is approximately 1/2 of a mile on your right.

## **Directions from Route 2 (west of Route 128)**

If you are travelling on Route 2 eastbound, take a right at Route 126 South. Take a left at Baker Bridge Road, which is 3/4 of a mile after the "Entering Lincoln" sign. At the end of the road, take a right on Sandy Pond Road. The Museum will be on your left.

#### **Directions from Route 495**

Take Route 2 East and follow above directions..

### **Directions from Mass Pike**

Take the Mass Pike to Route 128/I-95. Head north to exit 28B, Trapelo Road/Lincoln. You will drive approximately 3 miles to Lincoln center, a five road intersection. Sandy Pond Road is directly ahead. The DeCordova Museum is approximately 1/2 of a mile on your right.

### **Directions from Route 9**

Take Route 9 to Route 128. Head north to exit 28B, Trapelo Road/Lincoln. You will drive approximately 3 miles to Lincoln center, a five road intersection. Sandy Pond Road is directly ahead. The DeCordova Museum is approximately 1/2 of a mile on your right.

You can also take Route 9 to Route 126 North or Route 27 North, which eventually merges with Route 126. Follow Route 126 north towards Concord, take a right on Baker Bridge Road, which is 1 1/2 mile north of Route 117. At the end of the road, take a right on Sandy Pond Road. The Museum will be on your left.
