TTSGA POLICIES

MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the association is \$40 per year with \$105 prize money for the 27 tournaments scheduled. Prize money will be paid to the top 5 players in each of our five flights. Memberships are renewed at the beginning of each year at rates decided by the board of directors. Should a player drop out during the year his membership fee will not be refunded. He will receive a pro-ration of his prize money if his place can be filled from the waiting list.

There will be a picnic and an annual meeting scheduled for each year. The membership portion of a member's dues will entitle the member to attend both parties free of charge. A member's spouse or guest may attend the picnic free of charge but will be charged a fee for the annual party's dinner. An announcement will be sent out to members to RSVP well in advance of both parties.

There is a maximum of 145 players in the association.

TOURNAMENT RULES1/25/091/25/09

All members are automatically entered into each tournament. It is the player's responsibility to notify the Handicap Chairman by noon the day before the tournament if he cannot play or he will be considered to be a "no show". If a member has three "no shows", he will be asked to resign his membership without a refund of any monies paid. Players are required to register 30 minutes prior to tee time. Players who arrive at the players' check in table less than 30 minutes prior to tee off time will be penalized for being late. Example: Tee time is 8 AM and you arrive after 7:30 AM you will be considered late. Each player will be warned the first time of the infraction and on the second occasion or any subsequent occasion during the rest of the season the player will not be eligible to participate in winning any prize money or participate in any skills contests for prizes for that day's tournament. All scorecards must be turned in within 5 ½ hours of start of play or all players on the scorecard will be disqualified.

Players in the "A" flight will play from the club's regular tees with a maximum of 6100 yards and all other flights will play from the senior tees with the exception of players age 80 and up and those attaining 80 during the year will be allowed to play from the most forward tees on each course. They must notify the Handicap Chairman if they use the forward tee. Tee assignments will be printed on the tee sheets.

Player's guests are limited to 5 tournaments per year and no scrambles.

PRIZE MONEY: Tournament winnings will be paid once per year at the annual meeting. Checks will be mailed to those not attending.

Championships Tournament: A champion for each flight will be determined by play over 36 holes in back to back tournaments. Players' handicaps at the start of the first tournament will be used for both tournaments. All players must play in both tournaments on the same day at the same times to be eligible to win. The board will decide in January of each year as to the two tournaments selected.

Hole-In-One Pot: Members can voluntarily participate in this pot with the cost per member of \$5. The pot will be divided equally for each hole-in-one scored and paid out at the end of the year. Should there be no winners the pot and its participants will carry over to the next year. There is no refund should a member drop out.

WAITING LIST: Applicants on the waiting list may play in all tournaments except scrambles if an opening is available. If a potential member on the waiting list declines to join when his name comes up he will be dropped from the list. He will not be able to play as a guest for the balance of the year and cannot reapply for the waiting list until the next year. Should he drop off the list his money will be refunded. Persons on the waiting list may attend the members' picnic at a charge of \$6 per adult.
