## Electronic Portfolio Requirements

- ✓ This course is going to be "paperless". That means that everything will be saved on the WHS server. CD's may be brought in to backup student files.
- ✓ Students will be required to obtain an e-mail address that they can access for assignments and notes. Email will also be used to hand in assignments (<u>LHarris@winnacunnet.org</u>). Free e-mail accounts are available from Yahoo, Comcast, Hotmail, etc.
