# TESTIMONIES

In the name of Lord Jesus Christ I bear testimony. I'm Sis Shen Shiang from Sabah. This incident happened in year 2002, 15<sup>th</sup> December around midnight, when my mum and I had just fallen asleep.

That night we were the only ones staying at home because dad had gone outstation for work and my brother and sister had gone for the Short Term Theological Training Course. At about 1am, mum was suddenly awakened by a cockroach which was crawling on her hand. Then she went to the washroom to ease herself and went back to bed again. Suddenly she was awakened by shouts of "Fire! Fire!". She quickly got up from bed and woke me up. Hurriedly, we both prayed together in the living room and then mum packed some of our important documents. However, she could not find both our identity cards. The electricity suddenly went off and gradually the smoke was getting dangerously thick and it soon filled up the whole house. Mum and I had no other choice but to escape from the house and flee for our lives. We did not manage to bring along any valuable things but only the clothes and slippers we had on.

The fire was actually caused by a neighbour who lived just two houses away from us. As our house did not have a wall which could keep out the fire from spreading to our house therefore the fire was spreading fast to us. Suddenly we heard the sound of gas explosion and the fire became more and more serious. Smoke filled up the

whole place. Not long after that, the fire brigades came, and they spent almost two hours before they managed to put out the fire. By that time it was already 4 o'clock in the early morning. Mum and I slept in the car for the rest of the time and waited till dawn.



Around six in the morning, there was day light again. Mum and I quickly went back to the house. We saw the things in the living room were badly destroyed by the fire; the ceilings were ruined too. The cupboards and beds in the house were all ruined by the big fire. It had always kept me thinking that if that night the cockroach had not awaken my mum, both of us would have probably been burnt to death. This is the Lord's abundant grace and protection. Thank God the kitchen was not ruined. Besides, we also found our identity cards soaked in some water. They were not burnt by the fire. This was a great miracle to me and my family. We thank God for His guidance, love and care.

After the incident, many relatives, brothers and sisters in Christ donated clothes to us and gave us some financial support. Churches from other regions also contributed some money for us. May the Lord remember their love.
